If you would like a varied professional career working in the IT departments of international companies, enjoy other cultures and speaking English, the Federal VET Diploma in Information Technology Informatikerin/Informatiker EFZ is perfect for you.

What's special about this international apprenticeship?

English is the common language used in the international host companies. One of the aims of the program is to acquire an internationally recognized language certificate.


An entry level B2 German but there is no specified entry level for English, the aim is to increase the level of English by one level. This is achieved through participation in external language courses and two compulsory residential language study trips. Language options are coordinated by the bildzug network but must be funded by the trainees themselves. Some of the companies are sharing the costs.

Host company/VET school

Training is provided partly in English at all learning locations. This means that English is important and is used in class, in the inter-company industry courses and in the workplace. The final examination is in German. The syllabus is based on the IT vocational education and training (VET = Vocational education and training) ordinance and leads to the Swiss Federal Diploma.

Organization

In addition to the apprenticeship contract, an additional agreement is signed between the trainee and the host company. This sets guidelines on language courses and holiday dispensation to attend the residential language trips, as well as how costs are shared between trainee and host company.

An interest in technology and foreign languages
is important, as is being able to work
independently and as part of a team.
